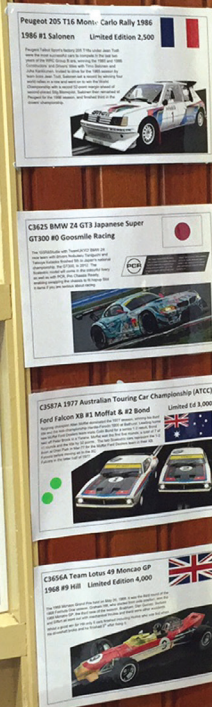


## SCAI EXTRIC IN AUSTRALIA
